Applications Close	Friday 25 th October 2024	The application closes. Make a note of this date as late applications will not be accepted.
Students Notified of Outcome	Early January 2025	This is where you are notified of the success of your application. If you are accepted, you will find out if you have been accepted into your first or possibly second Pathway preference.
