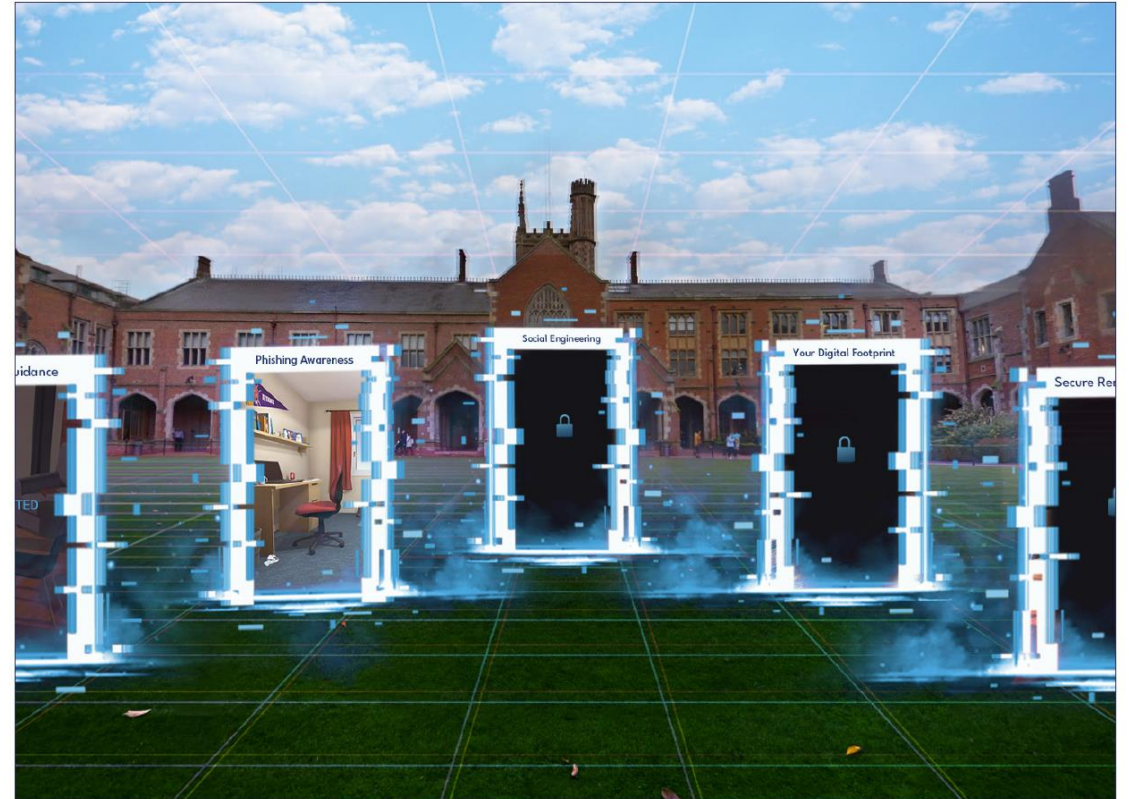

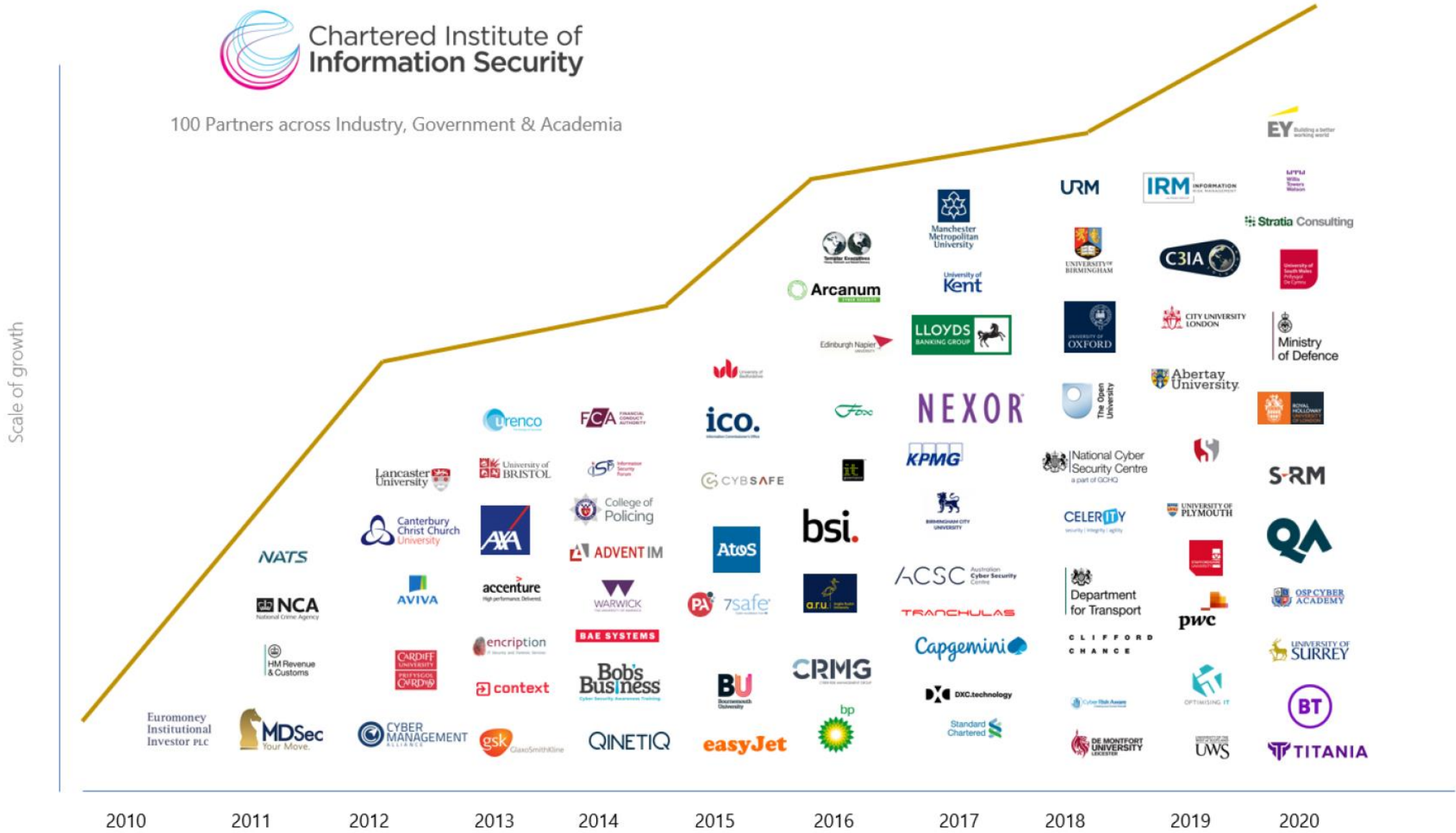
CIISec represents professionalism, integrity and excellence our principal objectives are

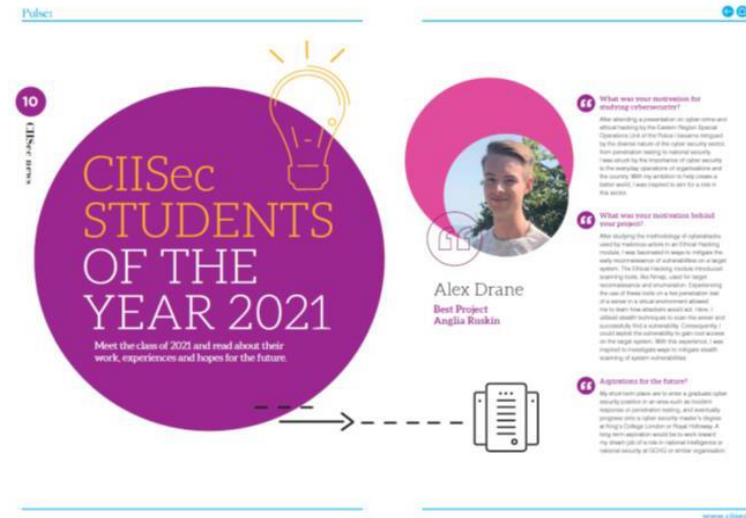


QUB as an Academic Partner
