

A student is classified as full-time, for fee calculation purposes, if the total CATS points of the courses that he/she is studying are greater than 90 CATS points. A full-time fee will be charged, based on the fee band for the course of study and will include all the semesters for the year.

The per CATS point fee is calculated by taking the full-time fee and dividing it by 120. The rationale for this is that a full-time course is made up out of 120 CATS points. Rounding will be applied.


