The **MSc in Biomedical and Clinical Research** begins in Sept 2025 and runs for 1-year full-time. The programme is research intensive, with a research project that spans across the entire year of the MSc.

MSc Course Outline

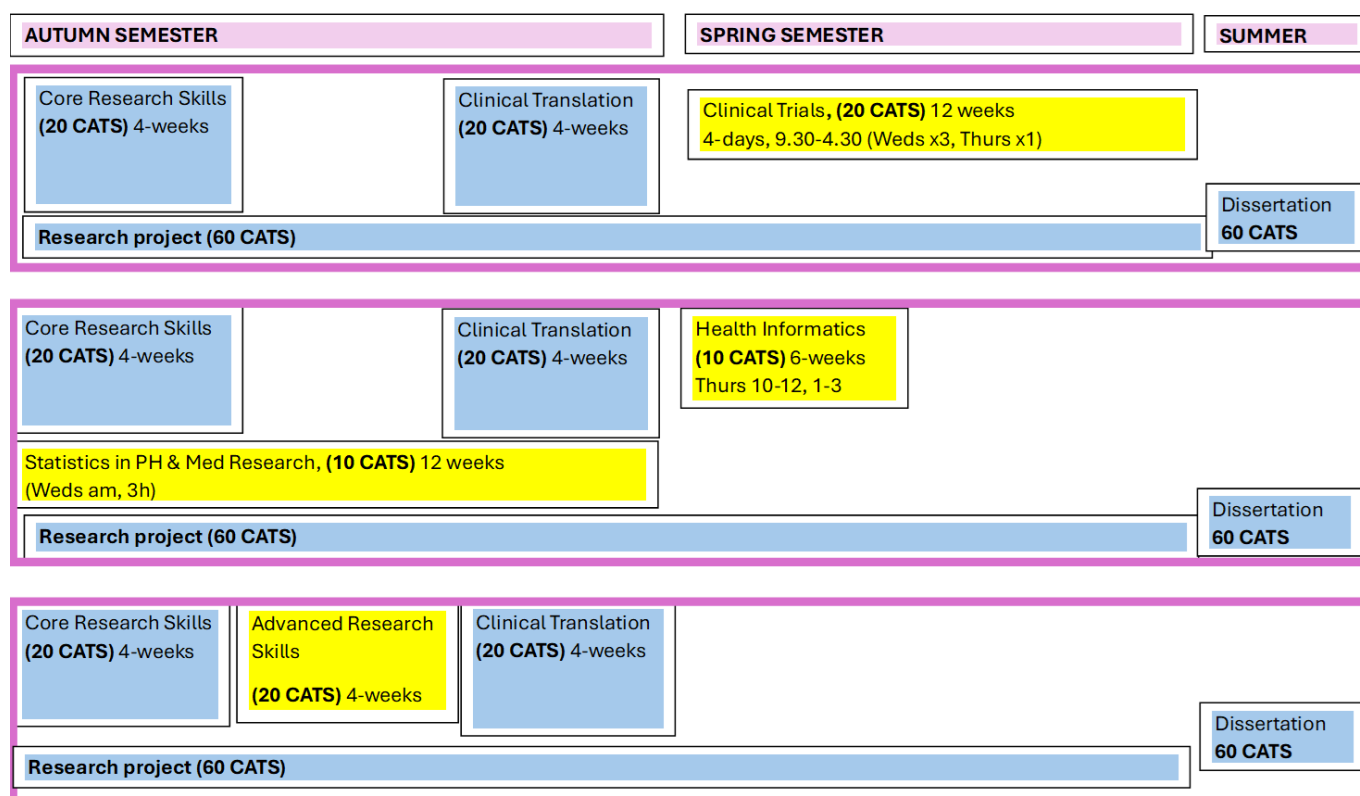
Core modules (highlighted in blue)

1. Core Research Skills
2. Clinical Translation
3. Research Project
4. Dissertation

Students can customise their studies by selecting one or two optional modules (highlighted in yellow) aligned with their research interests:

- Advanced Skills module - for laboratory-based biomedical or clinical projects
- Clinical Trials module - for clinical/pre-clinical themed projects
- Statistics in Public Health and Medical Research, and Health Informatics - for health and informatics-related projects
