

Queen's Management School (QMS) International Visiting Fellowship

The QMS International Visiting Fellowship scheme supports outstanding academics from any overseas country to spend up to 4 weeks conducting research at QMS. The scheme is open to academics at any career stage, and in any discipline aligned with a QMS department. The scheme will cover travel and accommodation costs for successful applicants.

Aims

The QMS International Visiting Fellowship scheme aims to support the school's on-going commitment to international engagement and outstanding research. Through this scheme QMS aims to:

- Build and strengthen links between QMS and excellent scholars and Business/Management Schools around the globe.
- Encourage the development of new international partnerships for collaborative research.

Requirements

Visiting Fellows should participate in the research life of the school during their visit. Visiting Fellows are expected to (but not limited to):

- Engage with relevant QMS staff and PhD students with the aim to advise/support academic research and develop new joint research projects.
- Present a research paper(s) at a QMS seminar series.
- Attend QMS research seminars and school events.

Value and Duration

The position lasts up to 4 weeks and is not remunerated, however the QMS Visiting Fellowship scheme will cover travel and accommodation costs for successful applicants. Visiting Fellows may start at any time during the year, subject to agreement by the department.

Visiting Scholars will be assigned office space and have access to all QMS facilities.

Eligibility

Candidates should hold a doctoral degree in a relevant discipline, show ability to publish in leading journals, and have a strong interest in engaging with other researchers and developing joint research projects.

Preference will be given to applicants that have not previously published research with a QMS co-author and applicants from partner universities.

Application process

To apply please email the Director of Internationalisation (c.coyle@qub.ac.uk) including the following information/documents:

- Curriculum vitae.
- Description of research objectives for the duration of the stay and anticipated dates of visit (1 page max).

Successful applicants will receive an official invitation letter with further instructions.

Deadline

Applications will be assessed at several points throughout the year.
